Local elections can sometimes be decided by a small number of votes, which means every ballot truly makes a difference. Smoke Detectors

East Spencer Fire Department in conjunction with the America Red Cross will install smoke detectors free of charge to residents of East Spencer.

The smoke detectors are free and must be installed by the fire department; they cannot be handed out.

If you need a detector installed in your residence, call 704-636-0055 and leave your name, address, and phone number. The fire department will call you back to schedule a time for installation.

Availability depends on the amount Red Cross has on hand at the time you call. If no smoke detectors are available, your name will be placed on a waiting list.
