TRASH SERVICES UPDATE

We understand that reliable trash service is important to our residents.

After carefully reviewing this year's budget, the Town has determined that we are unable to assume responsibility for trash collection at this time.

To ensure uninterrupted service, we have extended our partnership with Green For Life (GFL) for an additional two years. During this period, we will continue working closely with GFL to address any service concerns promptly and remain committed to providing our residents with dependable, high-quality waste collection services.
